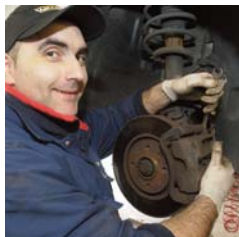

Mandy Giblin Coleg Llandrillo, Denbigh

In care from 12 months old, Mandy Giblin experienced abuse, prejudice and discrimination and never really felt as though she fitted in anywhere. Mandy left school with no qualifications and little faith in the Education system or its value in her life.

Eventually Mandy was sectioned under the Mental Health Act and in 1987 and it was here that she decided to try and turn her life around.

‘Having had lots of help I came off the medication,’ says Mandy ‘I started to feel happier and that perhaps I had a right to a normal life. I met a guy, we had a beautiful daughter and wedding plans were made for later that year. I felt the happiest person alive. However, this was short-lived.’

Tragically, Mandy’s partner killed a young woman before later killing himself in prison. ‘Life had no appeal any more,’ says Mandy, ‘I just wanted to die.’ For the next few years, Mandy took out the anger and frustration on herself, until in 1997 she was offered a new start in Denbigh in a mental health care home.

‘It was the best thing I ever did,’ continues Mandy ‘I was able to piece my life back together and started to find out why these awful things had happened to me. I began to grow in confidence and make new friends. I took courses with the Open University and in 2006 I attained my degree.



Since then Mandy has continued to complete numerous courses at Coleg Llandrillo Denbigh and changed her life immeasurably.

‘I met my mother, who I hadn’t seen in over 20 years. I thought she never loved me and that is why she put me into care. However, she explained what had happened and I began to understand more about my upbringing which is quite sad really.

I am also in contact with my daughter who is 20 this year. I telephone her each week and she is coming up for 3 days in April, just before her birthday. I cannot wait to meet her.

I am over the moon and I just want to say thank you to the tutors support in making this happen. They saw the good in me and I saw it in myself. You just need faith in yourselves and in those around you. So, go to college, make new friends and be the person you want to be as I have been there and done it and would not have it any other way.

Mewn gofal ers pan oedd yn 12 mis oed, profodd Mandy Giblin gamdriniaeth, rhagfarn a gwahaniaethu yn ei herbyn, a doedd hi erioed wedi teimlo'i bod yn ffitio i unman. Gadawodd yr ysgol heb unrhyw gymwysterau a heb fawr o ffydd yn y system Addysg na'i gwerth yn ei bywyd. Yn 1987 fe gafodd Mandy ei chadw dan y Ddeddf Iechyd Meddwl, a dyna pryd y penderfynodd roi cynnig ar newid ei bywyd.

Am yr ychydig flynnydoedd nesaf roedd Mandy'n cyfeirio'r dicter a'r rhwystredigaeth tuag ati ei hunan, nes iddi gael cynnig dechreuad newydd yn 1997 mewn cartref gofal iechyd meddwl yn Ninbych.

'Dyna'r peth gorau wnes i erioed,' meddai Mandy. 'Fe fedrais i roi fy mywyd yn ôl wrth ei gilydd a dechreuais ddarganfod pam fod y pethau ofnadwy yma wedi digwydd i mi. Dechreuais ennill hyder a gwneud ffrindiau newydd. Es ati i wneud cyrsiau gyda'r Brifysgol Agored a chefais fy ngradd yn 2006'



Ers hynny, mae Mandy wedi parhau i gwblhau nifer o gyrsiau yng Ngholeg Llandrillo, Dinbych ac mae ei bywyd wedi newid yn llwyr.

'Fe wnes gyfarfod â fy mam, nad oeddwn wedi'i gweld am fwy nag ugain mlynedd. R'on i'n meddwl nad oedd yn fy ngharu ac mai dyna pam roedd wedi fy rhoi mewn gofal. Fodd bynnag, fe wnaeth esbonio'r hyn oedd wedi digwydd go iawn ac fe wnes ddechrau ddeall mwy am fy magwraeth, sy'n eithaf trist a dweud y gwir.

Dwi hefyd mewn cyswllt gyda fy merch, sy'n 20 eleni. Dwi'n ei ffonio hi bob wythnos ac mae'n dod draw am dridiau ym mis Ebrill, yn union cyn ei phen-blwydd. Dwi'n edrych ymlaen yn fawr at gwrdd â hi.
